

ERRATA to the Full List of ICNCP Compliant Verified Cultivar Database Maples Including Classification and Trade Names

Version 1.4 March 31, 2026

1. 'Ume-ga-e' is misspelled as 'Uma-ga-e'
2. There are multiple typographical errors in the Classification groups, e.g. "Reticularum" instead of Reticulatum. In case of doubt, please refer to the Official Classification.
3. "Yamato" was incorrectly written as "Yamoto" on several occasions. "Yamato," meaning Japan, is the correct spelling.
4. The ICNCP name for 'Hana-yamato' was misspelled "Hana-yamamoto"
1. The cultivar *Acer* 'Vandermaat Red' (Red Wood Group) is missing from the List.
2. The cultivar *Acer* 'Vandermaat Yellow' (Red Wood Group) is missing from the List.
3. The cultivar *Acer rubrum* 'October Glory' is incorrectly listed. This entry should not be used, it is superseded by *Acer rubrum* 'PNI 0268' (OCTOBER GLORY). The cultivar 'October Glory' is incorrect and is elsewhere now recognized as a synonym of 'PNI 0268', but it is a trademark name, not a synonym in the formal sense.
4. In the listing for *Acer pectinatum* 'Alice', the species is incorrect. It should be listed as *Acer forrestii* 'Alice'. (ref TSO)
5. In the listing for *Acer pectinatum* 'Sirene', the species is incorrect. It should be listed as *Acer forrestii* 'Sirene'. (ref TSO)
6. In the listing for *Acer pectinatum* 'Sparkling', the species is incorrect. It should be listed as *Acer forrestii* 'Sparkling'. (ref TSO)
7. In the Convexum Group, both 'Little Green Star' and 'Little Green Stars' are listed. The latter should be ignored, it is an incorrect name, synonymous in the USA.
8. The entry *Acer* × *orientalia* 'Minorient' is incorrect, "× *orientalia*" is not a recognized hybrid, and is trademarked. The entry should read *Acer* 'Minorient' (ORIENTALIA).
9. *Acer* 'Serpentine' is incorrectly listed as *Acer davidii* 'Serpentine'. Although originally believed to be *davidii*, it is now recognized that this cultivar may well be of hybrid origin.
10. *Acer* × *freemania* 'Morgan' is improperly listed, it should be *Acer* × *freemania* 'Morgan' (INDIAN SUMMER)
11. Naniwa-beni (Corallinum Group) is incorrectly listed as Niniwa-beni.

12. *Acer* 'Oridono-nishiki' (Variegatum Group) is incorrectly listed without a hyphen, i.e. "Oridono nishiki."
13. *Acer* 'Redwine' (Palmatum Group) is incorrectly spelled as "Red Wine." This latter is usually given as the name in North America, but is incorrect.
14. *Acer* 'Hatsu-shigure' (Amoenum Group) is incorrectly given as "*Acer palmatum* 'Hatsu-shigure'", that is, without classification.
15. The trademark name for *Acer* 'INAG-E61' (ALPENGLow, Jack Frost Collection) is incorrectly given as ICE DRAGON.
16. *Acer* 'Chiyo-hime' (Palmatum Group) is missing from the list.
17. *Acer* 'Herhaim' (Red Wood Group) is missing from the list.
18. *Acer saccharinum* 'Sandersville' (HARVEST MOON) was omitted from the list.
19. *Acer* 'NicholsBros02' (KRYPTONITE) was omitted from the list.
20. *Acer rubrum* 'Olson' is listed incorrectly, with a missing trademark name. It should be *Acer rubrum* 'Olson' (NORTHFIRE).
21. The cultivar *Acer buergerianum* 'EOAB-1' (RAISING BLAZE) was incorrectly omitted.
22. The cultivar *Acer tataricum* subsp. *ginnala* 'JFS-UGA' (RED NOVEMBER) was incorrectly omitted.
23. The cultivar *Acer tataricum* 'Actar' (SUMMER SPLENDOR) was incorrectly omitted.
24. The cultivar *Acer rubrum* 'Supszam' (SUPERSONIC) was given under the incorrect species and epithet. It was incorrectly listed as *Acer platanoides* 'Supzam' (SUPERSONIC)
25. The cultivar *Acer* × 'Morton UW' (MORNING STARBURST) was listed with an incorrect trademark name, "MORNING SUNBURST." Please note that MORNING STARBURST™ is correct.
26. The cultivar *Acer* 'Vandermaat' (Dissectum Group) was incorrectly listed as *Acer* 'Dissectum Vandermaat'. Although Dick van der Maat introduced this cultivar as 'Dissectum Vandermaat', this is an illegal name under ICNCP rules, which state that latin (or latin-like) words may not be used in an epithet named after 1959. Therefore, the accepted name must simply be 'Vandermaat'.
