Venue - Day 1 and 2

Lectures and lunches will be held at Stonehouse Court (pictured above) on our first two days.



Venue - Day 3

Our third day's activities will be based at The Great Oak Hall, Westonbirt (pictured above).



Meals

All three days' lunches and Monday evening's banquet are included. Most British hotels serve breakfast.



Lodging

Multiple hotels are available in and around the charming Cotswolds market town of Tetbury (see our hotel list for details). Additional lodging is available at Stonehouse Court, however this hotel is not served by the shuttle on Sunday or Tuesday evenings.

If you plan to attend the Post-Symposium Garden Tour, our Tour ends in the Tetbury hub, so you may wish to reserve a room in Tetbury for October 30.

Transportation

Coach shuttle service will be provided between Tetbury, Westonbirt Arboretum, (and the adjacent Hare & Hounds hotel), Stonehouse Court, and Highgrove.

Cost per Attendee £320

Cost includes two classroom mornings with eight speakers, coffee, snacks, lunches, coach shuttle service to venues and Tetbury, the private Highgrove Garden tour, the guided Westonbirt introductory tour, use of the Great Oak Hall on Tuesday, the full day guided intensive exploration of the Westonbirt Maple Collection, and a three course gourmet banquet at Stonehouse Court. For traveling companions who only wish to attend the banquet, the price is £70.

Cost does not include lodging, Sunday and Tuesday dinners, and alcoholic drinks (which may be purchased separately at the banquet).
